Explanation:

SSLConfig secures Portal tomcat/jetty connectors with certificates, and the dr script automates Data Repository/Portal/DA backups. keytool is used for Spectrum HTTPS, and ssh-keygen relates to password-less SSH, not HTTPS or DR.

2. A tenant administrator needs to create dynamic groups that automatically include devices discovered via VNA and already synchronized with Spectrum.

Which minimum role right must be granted in the Portal?

- A. Administer Users
- B. Administer Groups Owned By You and Others
- C. View Performance Management
- D. Administer Thresholds

Answer: B

Explanation:

Only the Administer Groups Owned By You and Others right enables creating and editing both static and dynamic groups, regardless of the device origin (VNA, Spectrum, Flow, etc.).

3. You have imported Flow container images into a local Docker registry and deployed the Helm charts, but no flow records arrive in NetOps Portal dashboards.

Which two troubleshooting steps target both Kubernetes and NetOps integration layers? (Choose TWO)

- A. Verify Kafka topic configuration with kubectl logs on the flow-aggregator pod
- B. Check Flow-to-Portal REST tokens in southbounddata.log
- C. Confirm ip fix export on routers uses TCP/443
- D. Validate the VNA gateway status from OneClick Administration tab

Answer: A, B

Explanation:

Pod logs expose Helm/Kafka mis-wiring; southbounddata.log tracks Flow data transfer to Portal. IP FIX uses UDP/2055 or 4739, not HTTPS. VNA gateway is unrelated to Flow ingestion.

4. After upgrading Spectrum, OneClick search performance is slow and users complain about missing alarm enrichment from Performance Management.

Which integrated component should you rebuild to resolve both symptoms?

- A. Reporting Database indices
- B. Spectrum Global Collections
- C. IP Domain synchronization via the SSO Gateway
- D. The Discovery Cache in the DX NetOps Portal

Answer: D

Explanation:

A stale Portal Discovery Cache causes incomplete device meta-data sent to Spectrum, affecting alarm enrichment and Locator searches. Re-caching restores both performance and cross-launch accuracy.

5. True or false? When installing Spectrum in silent mode, pre-creating the Java keystore (cacerts) with a CA-signed certificate allows the -accept flag to bypass both the license and HTTPS prompts.

A. True

B. False

Answer: B

Explanation:

The -accept (or -agree) flag only answers the license EULA; HTTPS keystore prompts are independent and still require Jetty keytool commands post-installation.
